

Bear Lake Village Ordinance No. 2012.01

ANIMAL CONTROL

An ordinance to establish rules for the control of animals within the Bear Lake Village limits.

The Village of Bear Lake ORDAINS:

Section 1. Bear Lake Beach and Public Accesses

No person shall permit any animal owned by him/her or in his/her custody to enter or remain on the public beach known as "Bear Lake Beach" or the public accesses to Bear Lake.

Section 2. Leashes

No person shall permit any animal owned by him/her or in his/her custody to be in any public area, including the Bear Lake Beach or public accesses, unless on a leash or rope not over six (6) feet in length, except in certain areas designated by the Superintendent. All such areas shall be prominently posted.

Section 3. Cleanup

No owner or person having custody of any dog or other animal shall permit the animal to defecate on any public area, unless the defecation is removed immediately.

Section 4. Violations; Fines

Violation of this section shall be a municipal civil infraction, for which the fine shall be \$75.

Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances or parts of ordinances of Bear Lake Village inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Effective Date and Publication

This ordinance shall be published within fifteen (15) days after its passage and shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of its passage.
